

**NEW ALBANY FLOYD COUNTY SCHOOL CORPORATION'S
Alternative Supervised Physical Education
(ASPE)**

New Albany Floyd County School students may earn Physical Education II credit through an alternative supervised program (ASPE) during the fall, winter, spring, or summer sessions. ASPE does not count toward minimum course load requirements and IHSAA eligibility.

1. ASPE has been approved ONLY for the following activities:
 - a. All IHSAA School Sponsored sports
 - b. Cheerleading, Dance and Step Teams
 - c. Marching Band
2. The application for ASPE is available from a student's coach/sponsor/ counselor. The application must be completed and signed by the student, parent, counselor, and coach/sponsor /instructor.
3. Students may earn a maximum of one (1) credit for ASPE (Physical Education II).
4. To receive one (1) credit: A student must complete a season. A completed season is defined as **the "First Practice to the Final Event" consisting of a minimum of sixty hours of physical activity. The student must remain on the active roster for the entire season or duration of the activity.**
5. All students who complete a "defined season" (item #4) and complete the application will receive a "B" for Physical Education II course and the grade will be issued by a licensed Physical Education teacher.
6. To earn an "A" for the Physical Education II course a student must complete a Physical Education assessment established by the Physical Education Department of each school.
7. Failure to provide the proper documentation, failure to meet the indicated deadlines, or participate in an activity/sport different from what was approved will result in no credit being issued.
8. A student must petition for credit in the semester in which the sport/activity took place.
9. This wavier/course doesn't count toward passing 5 courses for eligibility.
10. The grade counts toward GPA but not class rank.

1. **A Student must complete this form and submit it to the counselor/coach/sponsor no later than the deadlines published each year by the school.**
2. **DOCUMENTING SUPERVISION: Coach/Instructor/Sponsor must:**

- a. Affirm the student was at the "First Practice", participated in the "Final Event" and completed a minimum of sixty hours of physical activity.
- b. Affirm the student was on the active roster for the entire season or duration of the activity
